He was a shop teacher for Hampton City Schools and generously used his skills to do numerous repairs around the church. He was part of the team that constructed the utility shed behind the church building.

In a like manner, Martha has been very active in CWF and women's ministries. She has served as president of the general CWF as well as group leader on numerous occasions. She was a physical education teacher for Hampton City Schools and for several years was the recreation leader for the Todds Lane Churches Ecumenical Vacation Church School, at its largest having over 100 students with 7 churches participating. Martha was an energetic worker in the twice yearly yard sales, the CWF fundraiser. When she and Bob became "snowbirds," she always returned from Florida with a generous supply of key lime juice to make tarts and to answer the requests for sugar-free desserts at the bake sales! She has attended regional CWF meetings and delighted in taking others with her.



Martha has seen opportunities to serve and encouraged others to participate. When a relative was teaching in Namibia and saw the need for English books in his school, Martha launched a drive in church that resulted in a small library for that school. For many years, Martha was a member of the Chancel Choir and participated in the handbell choir.
